[DHS Spring Sports Registration](#) - Any student who wishes to participate in a sport at Danvers High School this coming 2019 spring season can do so now through Friday March 8th by registering and paying* online at: www.danverspublicschools.org/dhs/athletics/ The Athletic Department MUST have in possession an updated physical and payment* MUST be received PRIOR to tryouts. These are clearance requirements, and will be strictly enforced. The start date for all spring sports is Monday March 18th. To avoid any delay in a student's participation on this start date, please make sure you register and have completed the clearance requirements by **Friday March 8th**.
