6. The **2019 Keys to Success Program** is once again brought to us by DEEP (Danvers Educational Enrichment Partnership) Corporate Partner *Michaud Mitsubishi* and owners Jill and Kevin Michaud. It's hard to believe this is the eleventh year of the program, and ten DHS students have won a certified pre-owned vehicle. As a school community, we are so grateful and appreciative of Jill and Kevin's generosity to the students of the Danvers Public Schools. The program has proven to be highly motivational for our students since its inception. The purpose of the Keys to Success Program is to recognize student improvement and kindness. Student reward/contract cards can be earned for Academic Improvement, Attendance Improvement, Service, Citizenship, and Kindness. All students are eligible for a card; however ninth (9th) graders will not be eligible for the "Key Off" in May due to their age. All other students will be eligible. No student may receive more than two (2) cards per year. The Key Off will be Thursday, May 23rd at 1:04 PM in the Field House.
