****DHS is closed for February break next week. We start back up on Monday, February 24th***

1. e-Learning Day - Danvers High School will have an e-Learning Day on Tuesday, March 3rd (DHS will be the voting site for the Primary Elections on this day). Students will be at home during the day and do not need to report to school.

Assignments for classes that run that day will be on Google Classroom for students to work on. Teachers will be available to answer student questions through Google Classroom and via email during their regularly scheduled class time. We wanted to clarify some questions that we have received from students over the past week:

- March 3rd is counting as one of our 180 days of school.
- Teachers will post assignments by the end of the day on Monday.
- Students need to complete assignments. Teachers will be available during regularly scheduled class time to answer student questions and provide feedback.
- Students have the flexibility on when to complete the assignments, as long it is completed by the assignment due date.

2. DESE Report Card - Every year, each public school and school district in Massachusetts receives a report card. Just as your child's report card shows how they are doing in different subjects, the school's report card is designed to show families how our school is doing in different areas. Dues pay for your child's senior yearbook, decorations, cap and gown and other graduation related expenses. We break down the full cost of \$120 into yearly payments to make it more manageable. 5. Attendance - The term "chronic absenteeism" is defined by the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) as missing 10% or more of the school year, or 18 days (2 days per month) during the 180 day school year. As we begin the second semester please make every effort to ensure all students are present and on time to DHS every morning by 7:30 AM. Interventions and supports can include attendance action plans, attendance intervention plans, and consequences outlined in the Attendance Policy of the student handbook [DHS 2019-2020 Student Handbook](#).

According to the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE), 95% of students with high attendance graduate in four years. Only 66% of students with low attendance graduate in four years. Attendance matters.

6. **Credit 4 Life** - Our annual Credit 4 Life Fair, sponsored by Brookline Bank (Previously First Ipswich), will be held for all 12th grade students on Tuesday, February 25th. It is being implemented a little differently this year as most of the planning has been done by three DECA seniors. The event will be held in the high school utilizing both the Field House and the Vye Gym. ***Students are expected to report to school at the regular 7:30 am start time and will be dismissed at the regular 1:55 pm dismissal.*** Please note 12th grade students will attend regularly scheduled first (A block) and last (F block) classes that day.
