**2. School Closure** - As Governor Baker announced, all schools in Massachusetts will be closed for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year.

**4. DHS Remote Learning Plan Update** - Monday marks the beginning of the next phase of our Remote Learning Plan, which will run Monday, May 4th through the end of the school year.

### **May 4th - June 18th**

Students will be given credit for submitting work assigned between April 6th and June 18th. Students should be checking their Google Classroom pages for assignments. Please contact us with questions. Special education questions can be directed to your child(ren)'s special education liaison. Teachers will also be available for office hours each school day to answer questions and support students.

Please encourage and remind students to check their Google Classrooms and Danvers email accounts each day to stay current on assignments and important updates.

Quarter 3, Quarter 4 and Semester 2 grades will be assessed on a Pass/Fail (Credit/No Credit basis). In addition, the following table provides more details on grades:

**Year end grades for all students will be calculated using the following scenarios:**

Semester 1 Pass + Quarter 3 Pass	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The Year End grade will be the semester 1 grade plus 3 percentage points.</li><li>• For example if a student got an 87% during Semester 1 and passed Quarter 3 then their final year end grade would be 90% (87%+ 3 points)</li></ul>
Semester 1 Fail + Semester 2 Pass	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• End of Year Grade determined on a case by case basis.</li></ul>
Semester 1 Fail + Semester 2 Fail	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>FOR SENIORS</b> - Students will work in an Senior Independent Study to complete missing work to earn a passing grade, if possible, in order to graduate.</li><li>• <b>FOR UNDERCLASSMEN</b> - we will work with teachers and students to examine each case individually.</li></ul>

We will not have **Final Exams** and will be providing students opportunities to practice Social Emotional Learning Competencies and reflect on their time with remote learning for the last week of school in June. Additional details to follow.

**5. Report Cards - Quarter 3** ended on April 9th for all students, including Seniors. All quarter 3 courses will be graded on a Pass/Fail (Credit/No Credit) basis. Quarter 3 grades will not be included in GPA or class rank calculations. Credit will not be withheld for any student due to access challenges. We will support families and be flexible during these challenging times. Directions on how to access Quarter 3 grades through Powerschool will be shared next week.

**6. 2020 AP Exams** - The College Board has released the revised exam schedule for this Spring. Please be sure to mark your calendars and continue your preparation on AP Central (<https://apstudents.collegeboard.org/>). Families can now pay for this year's AP exams using eFunds, and is the preferred method of payment. Log in the same as if you were going to pay athletic or other school fees. All AP families received a letter dated February 21, 2020 with the exact amount due. In eFunds you will select AP exams and enter the same amount and submit payment. **7. Spring 2020 Athletics Season** - The Spring Athletics season has been canceled. The Athletics Department is working on processing refunds for Spring sport registration fees.
