2. Remote Support Update

We wanted to provide a brief update regarding support for all DHS students on the days they are working asynchronously/at-home. We have developed a [remote support schedule](#) for students to check in with teachers in specific content areas. Although it may not be your student's actual classroom teacher, we are able to provide content expertise and support to your student during the school day. We also encourage students to continue to schedule office hour appointments with teachers as another means of additional support.

Because students are working independently, they will be able to access the support when it is available. There is a cohort specific Google Hangout Link which will be monitored by a faculty member at the designated times. We hope this will provide additional support to our students who are working while at home. Please contact us with any questions and/or feedback.

3. DHS Family Feedback Forum - As we continue with our reopening process, we would like to invite you to participate in the DHS Family Feedback Forum to share your successes and challenges with us. The forum will take place via a Zoom webinar on Thursday, November 5th from 4:30-6:00 pm

4. Breakfast at School We will be offering breakfast for all students beginning at 7:00 am. Students will go directly to the DHS cafeteria, which will be supervised by staff. Breakfast and lunch is free to all students through December with the support of a federal grant program.

5. Danvers Recreation Bathrooms - please remind your child(ren) that the bathrooms close to the Vye Gym are reserved for the Danvers Recreation program. We have had reports of DHS students using these bathrooms, and do have clear signage that the bathrooms are reserved as such. During lunch, DHS students can use the bathrooms by the Atrium/Cafeteria as well as the bathrooms closest to the Field House.

6. Attendance Reminders

Attendance will be taken everyday for all students, regardless of location.

- **Hybrid students who are at DHS for the day** - DHS faculty will take attendance during each class period
- **Remote students who are working directly with a teacher on screen for the day** - DHS Faculty will take attendance during each class period
- **Hybrid and Remote students who are doing asynchronous work that day** - we are asking students to utilize this Attendance [ATTENDANCE FORM](#) and sign in by 7:35 each morning. We will capture email addresses through the form, as it is time stamped for accuracy. Only students with Danvers email address will be able to access and use the form.
