7. Immunization Update: The MDPH Immunization Division has updated the 2021-2022 Immunization Requirements for School Entry <https://www.mass.gov/info-details/school-immunizations>. The update includes 1 dose of MenACWY (formerly MCV4) for student entry to grades 7 and 8 and 2 doses for entry to grades 11 and 12. Please note the second dose for MenACWY must be given on or after the 16th birthday.
