

Dice Game

Players: 2 or more

Materials: one die, index cards, magic marker, paper and pencil

Preparation: Choose words from your child's spelling list or the Dolch Sight Word List and write them on the index cards.

Objective: Child will practice reading sight words or words that follow a phonetic pattern. Younger children can identify letter names or sounds.

How to play the game: Write the name of each player on a piece of paper. Place the word cards face down in a pile.

The first player rolls the die, turns over the top card and reads the word. The adult writes the number that the player rolled on the die under the player's name.

Each player continues with his or her turn.

At the end of 15 minutes, the game is over.

The adult adds up the numbers. The person with the highest score wins the game.
