

## **Information Regarding Chromebook Insurance Coverage and Purchasing Information**

As part of the 1:1 Chromebook program at Danvers High School, each family is required to purchase accidental damage and theft insurance prior to the deployment of a Chromebook to your child. The insurance policy will be in effect for a full year from the date of purchase. The Danvers Public Schools will be the sole provider of this insurance. Under this insurance policy Chromebooks are protected against accidental damage including drops and spills, or loss due to theft. The Danvers Public Schools will require that a police report be submitted in cases of theft. Fraudulent reporting of theft will be turned over to the police for prosecution. A student making a false report will also be subject to disciplinary action as outlined by the school discipline code.

This insurance policy does not cover loss of the device's accessories such as chargers, cosmetic damage, or damages caused by intentional misuse and abuse. Families will be charged the cost of replacement if the damage is determined to be caused by intentional misuse and abuse.

The payment of \$30.00 for insurance coverage can only be made online. You will be required to enter your child's LASID number which is available on the PowerSchool Parent Portal (it is the number next to your child's name.) Payment will be made through your eFunds account. Be sure to designate the payment to Technology, not Athletics, Bus Fare, or Lunch Program.
