2019/2020 BUS REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN

Online Bus Registration

Bus registration for the 2019/2020 School year is now **open online**. All students who ride the bus **must register** and **submit payment*** at the time of registration. This will ensure a seat on the bus. Space availability is on a first come, first served basis. You will need your child's student ID number (LASID #), which is located on report cards for DHS, HRMS and elementary students or on the PowerSchool portal for DHS or HRMS student.

Early registration goes through July 5, 2019 - \$170.00 per student (maximum per family \$510)

Registration July 6 - August 16, 2019 - \$180.00 per student (maximum per family \$540)

In-Person Bus Registration

This will take place in the Central Office (located in Danvers High School, 60 Cabot Road) on the following date: **Monday July 22, 2019 from 7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.** Staff will be on hand to assist you with the process. Payments may be made online using a credit card or you may pay by check. **NO cash** payments will be accepted. Again, you will need your child's student ID number (LASID #), which is located on report cards for DHS, HRMS and elementary students or on the PowerSchool portal for DHS or HRMS student

Important Information, please read carefully

- * No student will be allowed to ride the bus without registering.
- * Your spot on the bus is **not guaranteed** if you do not register by August 16, 2019. (registration and payment are both required)
- * Bus stops are determined based on registrations.
- * Bus routes are posted on our website and subject to change throughout the year. An updated list will be posted at the end of August for the 2019/2020 school year.

- * Kindergarten students will not be dropped off if there is **not** an adult waiting for them at the bus stop. Kindergarten students **do not** get dropped off in front of their houses.
