



ATTENTION BUS REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN

Online Bus Registration - Gr. K-12

Bus registration for the 2021/2022 School year is now **open online**. All students who ride the bus **must register** and **submit payment*** at the time of registration. This will ensure a seat on the bus. Space availability is on a first come, first served basis. You will need your child's **student ID number (LASID #)**, which is located on the DHS or HRMS PowerSchool portal or on their report card. Elementary students can locate the student ID on their report card.

Early registration goes through July 9, 2021 - \$170.00 per student (maximum per family \$510)

Registration July 10 - August 13, 2021 - \$180.00 per student (maximum per family \$540)

Important Information, please read carefully

- **All** students must register for the bus, whether a new student or existing student.
- **Who is eligible:** Students in grades K-5 living over 1.0 miles from their school are eligible for transportation. Students in grades 6-12 living over 1.5 miles from the school are eligible for transportation. Your spot on the bus is **not** guaranteed if you do not register by August 13, 2021.
- **Waivers** - No Student will be denied transportation because of financial hardship. Bus fee waivers are available for students who qualify for free or reduced lunch, however the bus registration form must be completed each new school year. Applications for the 2021/2022 lunch application are not available until the month of August. Applications for free/reduced lunch should not be submitted before then.
- **Masks** - Per the State of MA masks will be required for all riders until further notice.
- **Bus stops** are determined based on registrations.
- **Bus routes** are posted on our website and subject to change throughout the year. An updated list will be posted at the end of August for the upcoming year. (<https://danverspublicschools.org/district/transportation>)
- **Kindergarten students** will not be dropped off if there is not an adult waiting for them at the bus stop. Kindergarten students **do not** get picked up or dropped off in front of their houses.
