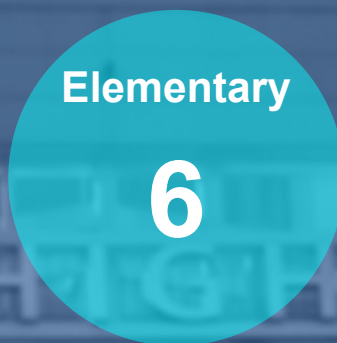

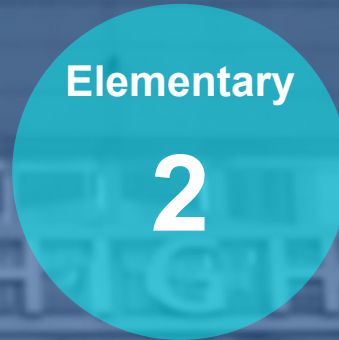

DESE Guidance and Optional Local Mask Opt Out Based on Vaccination Rates

- Mask mandate extended until at least November 1, 2021
- As of October 15, 2021, if a school demonstrates a vaccination rate of 80 percent or more of all students and staff in the school through an attestation form submitted to DESE, then vaccinated individuals in that school would no longer be subject to the mask requirement.
- Local decision to be made by school committee in consultation with local health officials and district leaders.
- Unvaccinated students and staff would be required to continue wearing masks.
- 80 percent threshold rate is to be calculated on a school-by-school basis. The threshold must be calculated including all enrolled students in the building plus any staff member regularly providing in-school services.
- Schools should determine a method to collect proof of COVID-19 vaccination for all eligible staff and students.
- All documentation related to an individual's vaccination should be maintained confidentially
